

# 2022 Post-Election: In-State Opportunities

Across party lines and issue areas, our in-state relationships, experience and influence run deep. The following are key 2022 election outcomes and insights in four states where Moore has boots on the ground.



## Florida

• **Governor Ron DeSantis (R) re-elected**

### New Congressional Members:

- FL-04: Aaron Bean (R) – Open seat as a result of redistricting
- FL-07: Cory Mills (R) – Incumbent Rep. Stephanie Murphy (D) retired
- FL-10: Maxell Frost (D) – Incumbent Rep. Val Demings (D) retired
- FL-13: Anna Luna (R) – Open seat as a result of redistricting
- FL-15: Laurel Lee (R) – Open seat as a result of redistricting
- FL-23: Jared Moskowitz (D) – Open seat as a result of redistricting

### 2023 State Legislature



- Republicans maintained control of the Florida House and Senate
- 54 newly elected state legislators

### Key Amendment Failed:

- **Constitution Revision Commission:** Keeps the Florida Constitution Revision Commission, which meets every 20 years to examine the state Constitution for possible changes
- **2023 State Legislative Session:** March 7 – May 5, 2023

## Louisiana

### New Congressional Members:

- No newly elected members of Congress

### 2023 State Legislature



- No newly elected State Legislators; elections to be held in 2023
- **Key Amendment Failed:**
  - **Slavery:** Keeps the state's current constitutional language banning slavery and involuntary servitude but allowing involuntary servitude as a punishment for crime
- **2023 State Legislative Session:** April 10 – June 8, 2023

## Georgia

• **Governor Brian Kemp (R) re-elected**

### New Congressional Members:

- U.S. Senate: Too close to call. Likely runoff election between incumbent Sen. Raphael Warnock (D) and Herschel Walker (R) to be held on December 6
- GA-06: Rich McCormick (R) – Open seat as a result of redistricting
- GA-10: Mike Collins (R) – Incumbent Rep. Jody Hice (R) retired

### 2023 State Legislature\*



\*Republicans maintained control of the Georgia House and Senate; however, not all races have been projected (7)

### Key Amendments Passed:

- **Compensation Suspension for Public Officials:** Allows the suspension of compensation of certain public officials while the individual is suspended from office for being indicted for a felony
- **Temporary Disaster Tax Relief:** Authorizes local governments to grant temporary property tax changes for properties damaged by disaster events and located within disaster areas
- **2023 State Legislative Session:** January 9 – March 30, 2023

## Mississippi

### New Congressional Members:

- MS-04: Mike Ezell (R) – Incumbent Rep. Steven Palazzo (R) defeated in primary

### 2023 State Legislature



- No newly elected state legislators; elections to be held in 2023
- No statewide ballot measures were certified to appear on the 2022 ballot
- **2023 State Legislative Session:** January 3 – April 3, 2023
